
OUR MISSION

WHAT IS THE OSSD?

The Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) is a certification awarded to high school graduates in the province of Ontario in Canada.

OSSD CREDIT REQUIREMENTS

In order to achieve the OSSD, a student must complete the following requirements:

18 COMPULSORY CREDITS

Students must earn the following compulsory credits to obtain the Ontario Secondary School Diploma:

4	credits in English (1 credit per grade) ¹
3	credits in mathematics (1 credit in Grade 11 or 12)
2	credits in science
1	credit in Canadian history
1	credit in Canadian geography
1	credit in the arts
1	credit in health and physical education
1	credit in French as a second language
0.5	credit in career studies
0.5	credit in civics

In addition, students must complete:

✓	12 optional credits ⁴
✓	40 hours of community involvement activities
✓	the provincial literacy requirement

Plus one credit from each of the following groups:

	• English or French as a second language ²
	• a Native language
	• a classical or international language
	• social sciences and the humanities
1	Group 2:
	• health and physical education
	• the arts
	• business studies
	• French as a second language ²
1	Group 3:
	• science (Grade 11 or 12)

	• computer studies

• cooperative education³

Note:

¹ A maximum of 3 credits in English as a second language (ESL) or English literacy development (ELD) may be counted towards the 4 compulsory credits in English, but the fourth must be a credit earned for a Grade 12 compulsory English course.

² In groups 1, 2 and 3, a maximum of 2 credits in French as a second language can count as compulsory credits, one from group 1 and one from either group 2 or group 3.

³ A maximum of 2 credits in cooperative education can count as compulsory credits.

⁴ The 12 optional credits may include up to 4 credits earned through approved dual credit courses.




